Reminders/To note

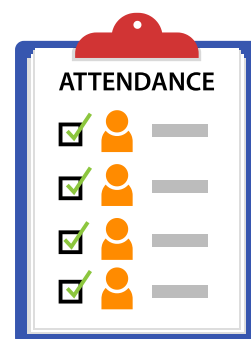
- Please remember to order your children's meals via the SwiftKitchen app

Regular Attendance Helps Children:

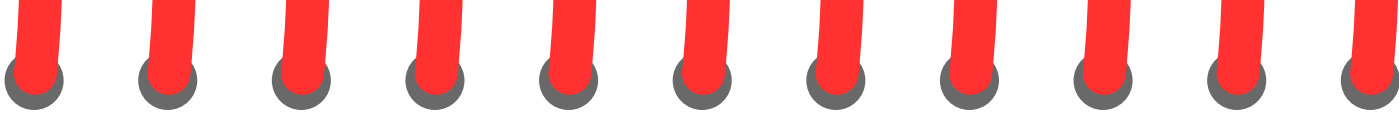
- Build strong friendships

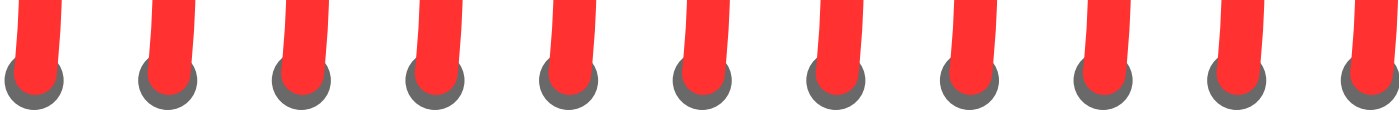

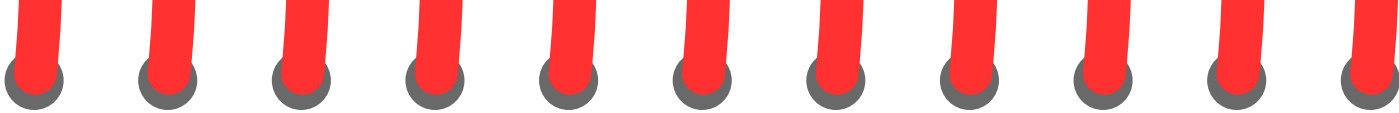
